## CANNABIS POLICY

Under the current legislation the only place that smoking or vaping of cannabis is allowed is within a residence and possibly on the property of the residence. Please note that Camp Neustadt is not a Provincial Park and is a privately run camp ground. This gives Camp Neustadt the discrimination in determining if cannabis should be allowed to be smoked on the property or not.

Several factors need to be considered when establishing a Cannabis Policy for Camp Neustadt.

- It is a family oriented camp ground
- Seasonal sites and casual camp sites are located close together
- Campers need to be respectful of their neighbours
- Smoking and vaping of cannabis can impact your neighbours enjoyment

It has been decided that smoking and vaping of cannabis will be allowed on the property, with the provision that if the use of cannabis on the property becomes a nuisance to your fellow camper's/guests then action may be taken in the form of a warning or violation.

### LOCATIONS WHERE CANNABIS CAN BE CONSUMED:

- In your trailer
- In your cabana
- On your Lot as listed on the licensee LTU renewal form

### LOCATIONS WHERE CANNABIS CANNOT BE CONSUMED:

- On the streets of the camp
- On the beach
- Soccer field
- At the play structures/playgrounds and public use spaces
- The east and west washrooms
- In the Beer Tent and surrounding outside area

### ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO CANNABIS USE:

- May not be consumed on the property by anyone under the age of 19 years
- May not be consumed in a motorized vehicle while driving on the property to the Lot
- May not be consumed when driving electric golf carts, e-scooters and e-bikes

### VIOLATION OF THE CANNABIS POLICY MAY RESULT IN THE FOLLOWING:

- Campers/guests may be given a written warning / written violation which will be filed for record with the LTU holder's Camp file.
